The Commission considered an assessment, prepared by legal (with counsel opinion) regarding the possibility of the Commission's intervention as *amicus curiae* in proceedings pursuant to S.10 (2)(e) of the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission Act, 2014 in relation to the following case:



The Commission decided not to proceed to intervene immediately. The Commission agreed that due to the significance of the issues, the legal team should keep a watching brief in respect of the interlocutory injunction proceedings listed for hearing on 2<sup>nd</sup> October 2018. It was agreed that at that time, a further meeting of the Commission will be convened to consider the matter further. The meeting was tentatively scheduled for Thursday, 4<sup>th</sup> October at 4:30pm.
